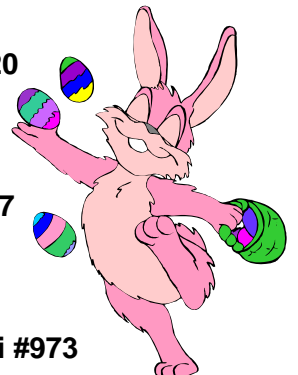

# MANAGERS NOTE

These last few months have been very wet and stormy. We have had a substantial amount of rain which has made many parts of the RV area unusable, as the ground is still total saturated and many a vehicle have had to be pulled out of the mud. It is best to call and check with us to get an update on what sites are and are not available.

The maintenance crew continues to work on various upgrades all around the ranch. You can take a ride around and find many areas that have changed. All clean up work continues to be priority. The housekeeping/lodge crew has been busy painting bathhouses. The stables crew has been busy helping with some of the grounds work, and you will notice that the main stables is as spic and span as stables can possibly be.

We have taken to the county the ranch plans and much more information than originally requested. These plans have maps of all the ranches acreage and facilities including all RV sites, cabins, pastures, sewer, electrical and water systems, electrical panels, etc. These plans are of great value to us here for information when needed for emergency repairs.

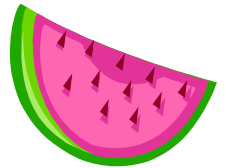

**\*Note; there will be no 8:00 or 9:30AM trail ride.**

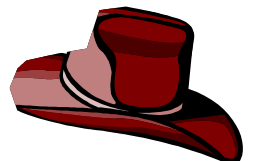
Any volunteers? If you want to help with any of these activities, please come see me at the stables.

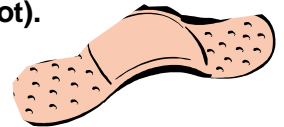
