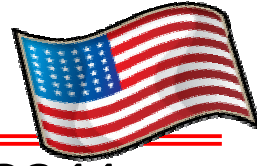

A big thanks to Nellie Cutright, who donated a 19" Color television with built in DVD player.

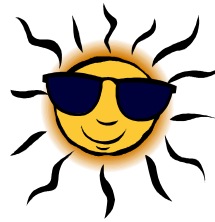


POTLUCK DINNER AND A BAND

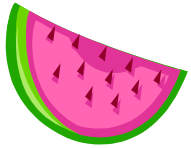

This ride is for advanced riders only, {6 people max}, this ride is going to be fun! Sign up form at the stables 8/6, 7:00am - 11:30am

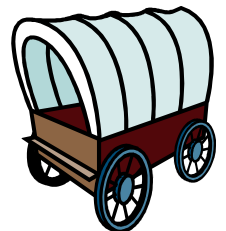
Sunday, August 14th @ 6pm - Evening Ride

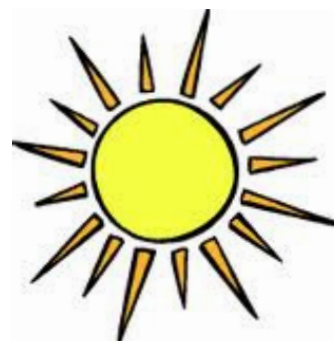
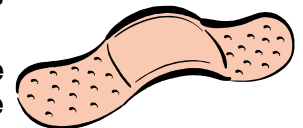
